A. Executive Director- Director Kobe reported that Jodi Ross resigned from her position as Executive Secretary. The position was re-classified at Certification/Licensure Examiner 1, which more closely meets the current duties of the position. Applications were received through the state's online application system. Almost 260 applications were received. Interviews were conducted and an offer was extended to an employee of the Veterinary Medical Board, with a start date of October 12. (Note: On September 20, the candidate withdrew his acceptance, as he had accepted another position at the Vet Board, which had opened in the interim. New interviews will be conducted.)

B. AIA Ohio-Mr. Hollenbeck was unable to attend but said he was looking forward to seeing the Board members at the AIA Ohio Convention in Toledo in two weeks.

4. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. AIA Convention Presentation- Director Kobe will be the moderator; Board members will study the proposed discussion questions and be prepared to speak on each topic.

B. NCARB Spring Meeting-The Board reviewed potential programs and venues with NCARB Region IV Executive Administrator, Glenda Loving. The recommendations will be reviewed and approved by the Region's officers, and she will make all of the necessary arrangements.

5. NEW BUSINESS

A. 5 Year Rolling Clock- NCARB has decided to delay implementation of the rule, "Applying the Five-Year Rolling Clock to Previously Passed Divisions and the Authorization to Test", because of the cost of implementation. Whether or not Ohio can implement its parallel rule is dependent upon our ability to get the ARE scores into ELicense. A follow up report will be made at the November meeting.
