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### ADJUDICATION ORDER

Pursuant to a meeting of the Ohio Architects Board, the following matter came before the Board on January 23, 2009. Members of the Board present were: Stephen L. Sharp, Richard L. Bowen and Richard J. Fleischman.

### ORDER OF THE BOARD

Stephen L. Sharp, Richard L. Bowen and Richard J. Fleischman reviewed and considered the evidence received in this matter related to the February 2008 revocation of Mr. Moore's license to practice architecture in Missouri as a result of his July 2007 felony conviction of a sexual offense in the state of Missouri.

It should be noted that Mr. Moore, who was sent via certified mail, a Notice of Opportunity letter dated October 14, 2008 did not request an administrative hearing.

Thereupon, the Board took the following actions in this matter:

1. Mr. Moore's certificate of qualification to practice architecture in Ohio, Certificate No. 13715, is hereby *REVOKED* for violation of Ohio Revised Code section 4703.15 (A) (2) and Ohio Administrative Code sections 4703-1-01 (F), 4703-3-07 (D) (3) and 4703-3-07 (E) (4).
2. Mr. Moore may apply for reinstatement of his certificate of qualification to practice architecture in Ohio pursuant to the terms, conditions and fees set forth in Ohio Revised Code section 4703.15 and Ohio Administrative Code section 4703-1-04 (E).

Allen R. Moore is hereby officially informed that Ohio Revised Code Sections 4703.06, 4703.18 (A) and 4703.99 make it a violation to assume or use the title or designation of "Architect" or "Registered Architect", or to hold himself out to be any of the above, or to engage in the practice of architecture unless properly licensed to do so by the Board.

The Board hereby orders you to immediately cease and desist any further use of any of the aforementioned designations, performing any of the aforementioned work, or to in any way hold yourself out to be qualified and permitted to practice as an "Architect" in the state of Ohio. The use of any advertisements, letterhead, business cards, signs, or other materials that in any way improperly portray you as a practitioner within Ohio should be stopped.


#### **CERTIFICATION**

I hereby certify that the foregoing Adjudication Order of the Ohio Architects Board is true and accurate as it appears in the journal of the Board at its proceedings on January 23, 2009.

This order may be appealed in accordance with Section 119.12 of the Ohio Revised Code by filing an original Notice of Appeal with the Ohio Architects Board, 77 South High Street, 16<sup>th</sup> Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215-6108, and also a copy of that Notice of Appeal with the Court of Common Pleas in the county of the respondent's place of business, or in the county in which the respondent is a resident, or with the Court of Common Pleas in Franklin County, Ohio if not a resident of Ohio.

Such notice of Appeal shall contain the Order appealed from and the grounds of such an appeal. Such notice of Appeal and copy shall be filed and must be received within fifteen (15) days after receipt of this Adjudication Order.
