Upon consideration of the evidence presented at this hearing held on August 18, 1989, the Board of Examiners of Architects makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Between January 1, 1980 and May 25, 1989, Lineen Hanna did not hold a certificate of qualification to practice architecture renewed under sections 4703.01 to 4703.19 of the Revised Code.
2. Between January 1, 1980 and May 25, 1989, Lineen Hanna did represent himself to be an architect, and
3. During said period, Lineen Hanna did enter upon the practice of architecture as defined in Rule 4703-1-01(B) of the Administrative Code.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Ohio Revised Code is the governing authority in this action.
2. The Board of Examiners of Architects concludes that Lineen Hanna represented himself as an architect during the period of January 1, 1980 to May 25, 1989 in violation of section 4703.06 of the Revised Code.
3. The Board of Examiners of Architects concludes that Lineen Hanna violated paragraph (B) of section 4703.15 of the Revised Code.
4. The Board of Examiners of Architects finds the allegation that Lineen Hanna violated paragraph (C) of section 4703.15 of the Revised Code is not proven by a preponderance of evidence and, therefore, dismissed said allegation.
5. The Board of Examiners of Architects concludes that Lineen Hanna entered upon the practice of architecture and held himself forth as an architect during the period of January 1, 1980 to May 25, 1989 in violation of paragraph (A) of section 4703.18 of the Revised Code.


6. The Board of Examiners of Architects finds the allegations that Lineen Hanna violated paragraphs (D)(1) and (E)(3) of Rule 4703-1-09 of the Administrative Code are not proven by a preponderance of evidence and, therefore, dismisses said allegations.
7. The Board of Examiners of Architects concludes that Lineen Hanna did not comply with the Registration laws in the state of Ohio in violation of paragraph (D)(3) of Rules 4703-1-09 of the Administrative Code.

ORDER

Therefore, the Board of Examiners of Architects hereby orders the certificate of qualification of Lineen Hanna reinstated and that said certificate be suspended for a period of two years from the date of the mailing of this Adjudication Order.

This order may be appealed pursuant to section 119.12 of the Revised Code by filing a Notice of Appeal with the Ohio Board of Examiners of Architects, 77 S. High Street, 16th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43266-0303 and also filing a copy with the Court of Common Pleas in the county of your place of business, or in the county in which you are a resident. Such Notice of Appeal shall set forth the Order appealed from and the grounds of such appeal. Any such Notice of Appeal must be filed with both the Ohio Board of Examiners of Architects and the correct Court of Common Pleas within fifteen (15) days after the mailing of this Adjudication Order.
