ADJUDICATION ORDER

Pursuant to a meeting of the State of Ohio, Board of Examiners of Architects, the following matter came before the Board on March 3, 2006. Members of the Board present were: Leon Humphries, Gerald S. Hammond, Richard J. Fleischman and Stephen L. Sharp.

ORDER OF THE BOARD

Leon Humphries, Gerald S. Hammond, Richard J. Fleischman and Stephen L. Sharp reviewed and considered the Report and Recommendation of the hearing officer. No written objections were submitted on behalf of Mr. Breitweiser.

Thereupon, the Board took the following actions in this matter:

1. The Board approves and adopts the findings of fact, conclusions of law; and recommendation as set forth in the Report and Recommendation.
2. Mr. Breitweiser's certificate of qualification to practice architecture in Ohio, Certificate No. 6970, is hereby *REVOKED*.
3. Mr. Breitweiser may apply for reinstatement of his certificate of qualification to practice architecture in Ohio pursuant to the terms, conditions and fees set forth in Ohio Revised Code sections 4703.15, 4703.16 (C) (3) and Ohio Administrative Code section 4703-1-04 (E).



Alvah P. Breitweiser is hereby officially informed that Ohio Revised Code Sections 4703.06, 4703.18 (A) and 4703.99 make it a violation to assume or use the title or designation of "Architect" or "Registered Architect", or to hold himself out to be any of the above, or to engage in the practice of architecture unless properly licensed to do so by the Board.

The Board hereby orders you to immediately **cease and desist** any further use of any of the aforementioned designations, performing any of the aforementioned work, or to in any way hold yourself out to be qualified and permitted to practice as an "Architect" in the state of Ohio. The use of any advertisements, letterhead, business cards, signs, or other materials that in any way improperly portray you as a practitioner within Ohio should be stopped.


CERTIFICATION

I hereby certify that the foregoing Adjudication Order of the State of Ohio, Board of Examiners of Architects is true and accurate as it appears in the journal of the Board at its proceedings on March 3, 2006.

This order may be appealed in accordance with Section 119.12 of the Ohio Revised Code by filing a Notice of Appeal with the State of Ohio, Board of Examiners of Architects, 77 South High Street, 16th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215-6108, and also a copy of that Notice of Appeal with the Court of Common Pleas in the county of the respondent's place of business, or in the county in which the respondent is a resident, or with the Court of Common Pleas in Franklin County, Ohio if not a resident of Ohio.

Such notice of Appeal shall contain the Order appealed from and the grounds of such an appeal. Such notice of Appeal and copy shall be filed and must be received within fifteen (15) days after the mailing of this Adjudication Order.
