ADJUDICATION ORDER

Pursuant to a meeting of the Ohio Architects Board, the following matter came before the Board on June 2, 2014. Members of the Board present were: Stephen L. Sharp, Richard L. Bowen and John P. Rademacher.

ORDER OF THE BOARD

Stephen L. Sharp, Richard L. Bowen and John P. Rademacher reviewed and considered the Report and Recommendation of the hearing officer, the case exhibits and the written objections submitted by Mr. Miller.

Thereupon, the Board took the following actions in this matter:

1. The Board approves and adopts the findings of fact and conclusions of law as set forth in the hearing officer's report, but modifies its recommendation to the extent that Larry A. Miller will not be required to complete the NCARB Ethics and Professional Rules of Conduct monograph.
2. The Board hereby orders Larry A. Miller to pay in full, a fine of \$1,000.00 (One-Thousand Dollars) no later than August 4, 2014 via credit card, check or money order made payable to the "Treasurer, State of Ohio".
3. The failure of Larry A. Miller to pay his fine in full by the above deadline will result in an immediate and indefinite suspension of his certificate of qualification to practice architecture until such time as his fine has been paid in full.

TIME AND METHOD TO PERFECT AN APPEAL

Any party desiring to appeal shall file a Notice of Appeal with the Ohio Architects Board, 77 South High Street, 16th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215-6108, setting forth the order appealed from and stating the Board's order is not supported by reliable, probative, and substantial evidence and is not in accordance with law.

The Notice of Appeal may, but need not; set forth the specific grounds of the party's appeal beyond the statement that the Board's order is not supported by reliable, probative and substantial evidence and is not in accordance with law.

The Notice of Appeal shall also be filed by the appellant with the Court of Common Pleas in the county of the appellant's place of business, or in the county in which the appellant is a resident, or with the Court of Common Pleas in Franklin County, Ohio if not a resident of Ohio. Such notices of appeal shall be filed within fifteen (15) days after the mailing of the notice of the Board's order as provided in Section 119.12 of the Ohio Revised Code.
