ADJUDICATION ORDER

Pursuant to a meeting of the Ohio Architects Board, the following matter came before the Board on May 6, 2011. Members of the Board present were: Jeffrey Skapin, Richard J. Fleischman, Stephen L. Sharp and Richard L. Bowen.

ORDER OF THE BOARD

Jeffrey Skapin, Richard J. Fleischman, Stephen L. Sharp and Richard L. Bowen, reviewed and considered the Report and Recommendation of the hearing officer and the case exhibits.

Thereupon, the Board took the following actions in this matter:

1. The Board approves and adopts the findings of fact, conclusions of law; and recommendation as set forth in the Report and Recommendation.
2. Mr. Fields is hereby reprimanded for his actions, and ordered to pay in full, a monetary fine of \$1,000 /One-Thousand Dollars to the Board no later than December 1, 2011. Check or money order made payable to the "Treasurer, State of Ohio".

Mr. Fields is permitted to make minimum monthly payments of at least \$166.67 due the 1st day of each month, with the first payment due on or before July 1, 2011.

3. Should Mr. Fields fail to make the minimum monthly payments set forth by the Board, or fail to pay the total fine by December 1, 2011, his license will be revoked.


TIME AND METHOD TO PERFECT AN APPEAL

Any party desiring to appeal shall file a Notice of Appeal with the Ohio Architects Board, 77 South High Street, 16th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215-6108, setting forth the order appealed from and stating the Board's order is not supported by reliable, probative, and substantial evidence and is not in accordance with law.

The Notice of Appeal may, but need not, set forth the specific grounds of the party's appeal beyond the statement that the Board's order is not supported by reliable, probative and substantial evidence and is not in accordance with law.

The Notice of Appeal shall also be filed by the appellant with the Court of Common Pleas in the county of the appellant's place of business, or in the county in which the appellant is a resident, or with the Court of Common Pleas in Franklin County, Ohio if not a resident of Ohio. Such notices of appeal shall be filed within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the notice of the Board's order as provided in Section 119.12 of the Ohio Revised Code.
